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THE PERFECT WORK DAY IN SHOREDITCH



Early Start: Kick things off with a sweat at Blok Shoreditch boxing class.

Morning: Head over to Jolene's Bakery for fresh pastries and a speciality coffee. The perfect fuel to face the rest of the workday.

Mid-morning: Have a break from circling back and responding to emails and stop in at Brick Lane Vintage. The underground market is full of different boutiques, independent labels, and street art that changes every week. It's on the expensive side, but there's always something when you start digging.



Lunch: Grab a bite at Spitalfields Market. From artisanal sandwiches to street food of all cultures, the market is buzzing with energy and options. Plus, you never have to agree with your colleagues on what's for lunch.

Evening Drinks: Find a bar with a geometric twist, where cocktails are inspired by shapes and served with a playful touch. We suggest Oranj or A Bar with Shapes for Names.

Dinner: Round off the day at Noisy Oyster. Seafood lovers, this is where you want to be. Our full review is on the next page, but expect fresh oysters, caviar, and a dining experience worth booking for.

Newest venue in Shoreditch, Noisy Oyster brings brutalist, industrial design alongside delicate, elevated seafood.



Noisy Oyster, the latest project from the team behind Firebird, brings a seafood-led menu to an interior that feels as if a building site and an art installation had a quiet word with each other.

The design comes from Harry Nuriev of Crosby Studios, whose reputation for turning interiors into cultural statements is well established. It feels unfinished in a curated way, creating an atmosphere that contrasts beautifully with the precision of what arrives on the plate.

There is a touch of the Shoreditch hipster aesthetic you would expect but executed in a way that feels considered rather than clichéd. Perhaps that comes with a caviar menu, an expensive bill, and all chrome interiors, but the space makes its point and does well in adding to the overall experience.

We started with oysters, perfectly light for the hot summer's day we visited on (sorry we know there are no more of these coming). One dressed oyster in particular stole the show; fresh, briny, and paired with tomato water and a side of horseradish crème fraîche. The two flavours worked in complete harmony without overpowering the oyster itself.

The bluefin tuna tartare was well executed in terms of flavour, acidic and accented with dill, but the addition of cucumber introduced a slightly odd texture. While the intention was likely to add texture, it slightly disrupted the otherwise clean, balanced feel of the dish.

During our visit, an exclusive caviar menu was available, including red caviar toast and a maritotzo topped with Oscietra caviar. Both dishes felt indulgent yet never heavy, continuing the theme of freshness and precision that ran throughout the meal.

Early reviews suggested the service was still finding its rhythm but on our visit, this was not the case. The team were attentive without overstepping, offering thoughtful recommendations and pairing wines that complemented each course. It felt knowledgeable and relaxed, a sign that the operation is settling in smoothly.

The Verdict

The Noisy Oyster is great for seafood lovers who respect a vibe as much as the food. For those looking for something new in Shoreditch, this is worth your time.

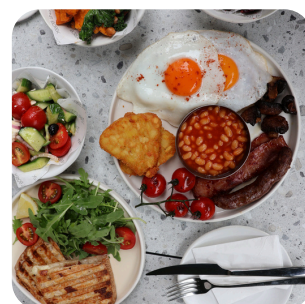
SAUNOS

KEU SOHO

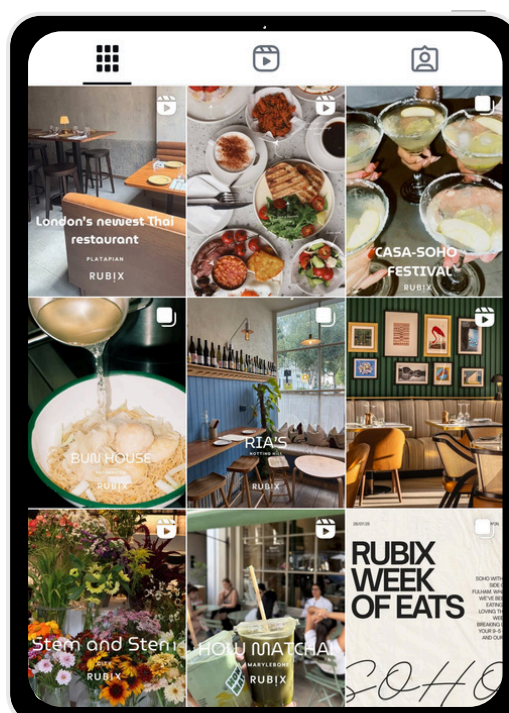
